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Enhancing the Skill of Preparing Ledger A/C of F.Y.J.C Students in the Subject Bookkeeping

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Abstract: This research article focuses on enhancing the skill of preparing ledger accounts for First Year Junior College (F.Y.J.C.) students in the subject of bookkeeping.
