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Analysis of the Functionality of Information Technology in the Classroom

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Abstract: The grandeur of a nation is significantly influenced by the educational system that is implemented to develop its talent. It is imperative that the young minds of this nation be imparted with a spirit of healthy competition, given the world's transformation into a global village and the increasing prominence of the digital era.
