The people within the age of 15 to 25 were my sample for this research and my sample size is 60

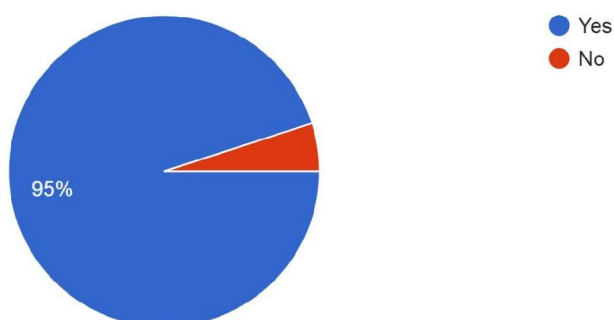
### Data collection :

Did you saw any LGBTQ+ character in any movie/ series/ drama ?

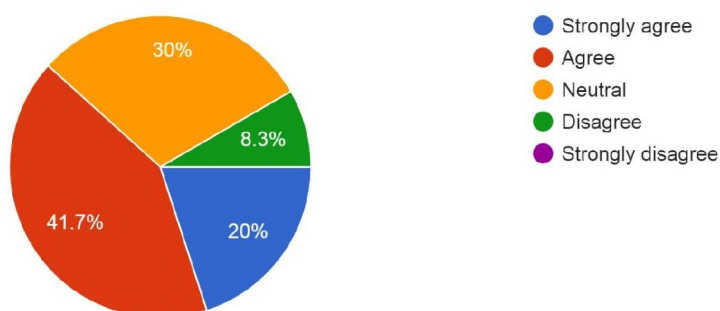

The way entertainment industry represent any community effects how people treat them in real life

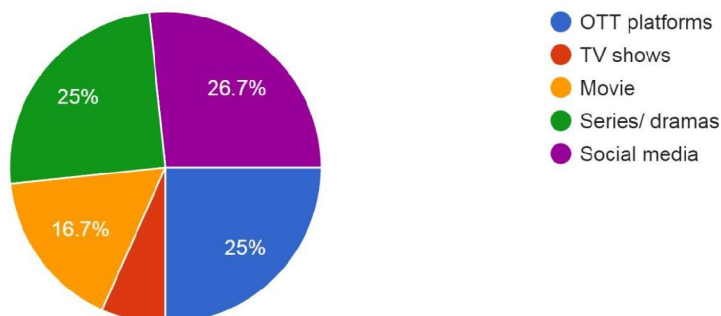

From which platform you get to know about LGBTQ+ community ?

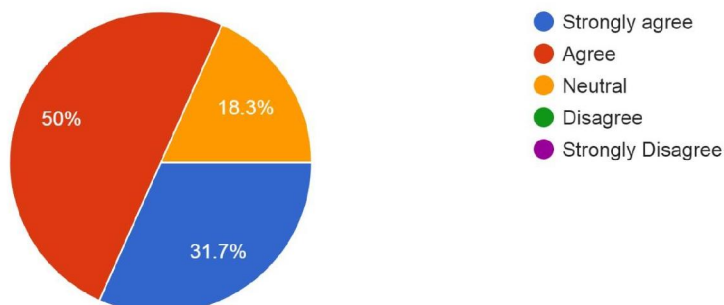

Because of movie and series people get to know about the problems and issues LGBTQ+ community faced

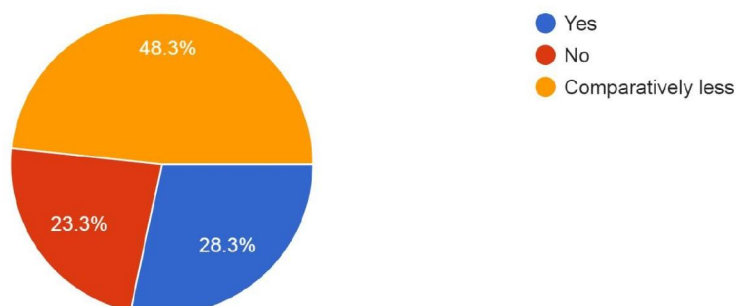
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50%% of people agree with this statement and 31.7% of people strongly agree . And 18.3% neutral

In old Bollywood movies the gay character's were only for cheap comedy do you think it is still going on in Bollywood?

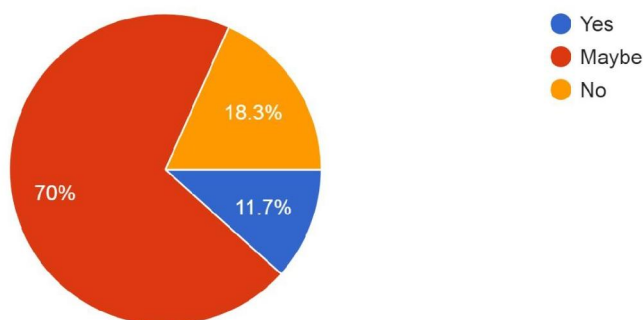

Do you think entertainment industry portraying this community in a right way

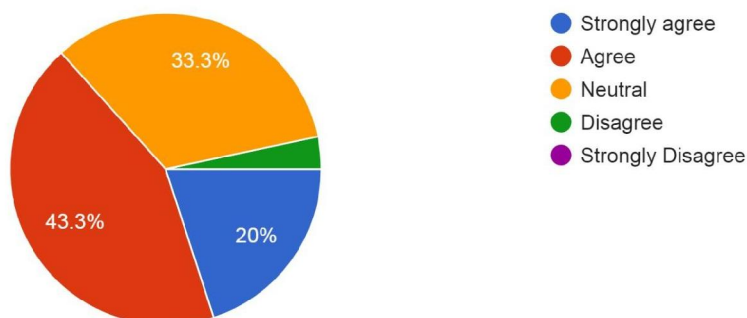
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70% people are not sure about the industry portrayal, whereas 11.7% said yes and 18.3% people said no industries are not portraying this community in a right way.

Entertainment industry use to show gay characters as Horny and happy all the time

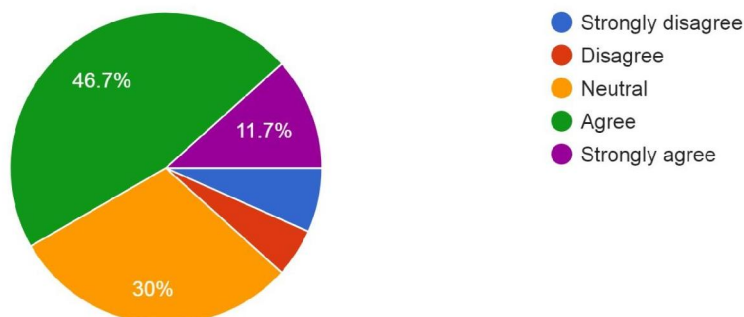
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43.3%of the people agree with this statement, then 33.3% neutral and 20% strongly agree and remaining disagree

The representation of LGBTQ community is getting better nowadays then early movies

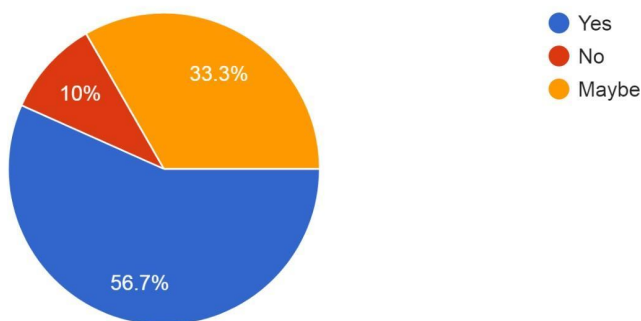
